

REGISTRATION

- There will be **three registration options** this year:
 - Option #1** - Overnight at Camp Eden.
\$55 members/\$60 non-members
 - Option #2** - Overnight at Eldora Lodge*.
\$65 members/\$70 non-members
 - Option #3** - No overnight.
\$25 members/\$30 non-members
- **Registration begins February 5th and ends March 31st.**
- **Registration deadline for Option #2 is February 28th, with a non-refundable deposit of \$10 due at time of registration and the balance due by March 31st.**
- **Late registration (April 1st-21st):** Add \$5 to Option #1 and #3 (late registration is not available for Option #2).

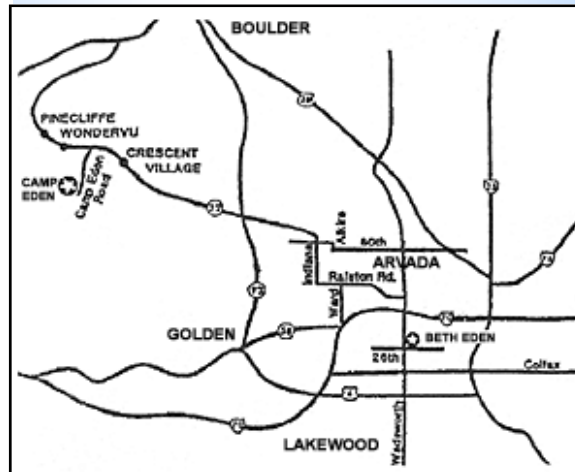
DIRECTIONS

Camp Eden is located off CO Hwy 72 in Coal Creek Canyon in the Roosevelt National Forest. It sits in a valley known as Black Gulch, directly beneath Mount Thoradin (10,555 ft.) This location enables the users of Camp Eden numerous hours of outdoor pleasure.

To Reach Camp Eden:

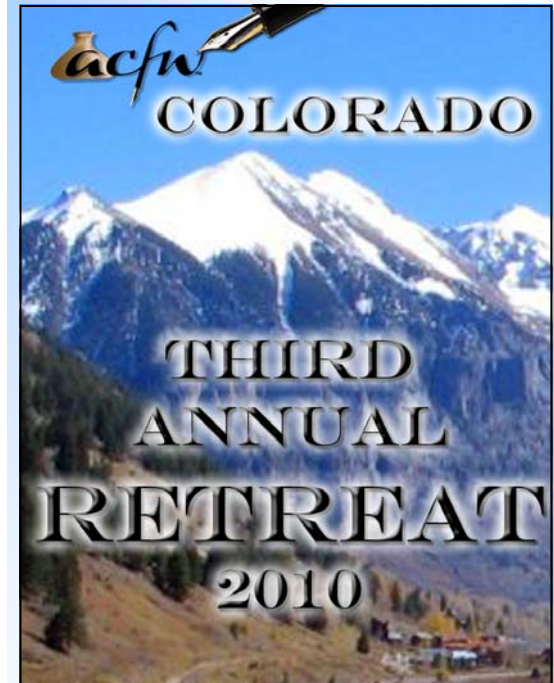
- From I-25, take **US Hwy 6** (exit 209B)
- Merge onto **CO-93/Foothills Rd.** (13 miles)
NOTE: At this intersection, US-6 turns left into Clear Creek Canyon. You will want to go straight through the intersection to CO-93. It is well marked.
- North on **CO Hwy 93** to **CO Hwy 72** (8.2 miles).
- West on **CO Hwy 72** to **Camp Eden Road**. This is one-and-a-half miles past Crescent Village.
- Turn Left on **Camp Eden Road**
- Go two miles to Camp Eden
